## Camp Sayre Campout - Personal Gear List

Camp Sayre is part of Minuteman Council and includes over 100 acres of wooded hills in Blue Hills Reservation. Blue Hills Reservation encompasses over 7,000 acres, providing the largest open space within 35 miles of Boston. There are over 125 miles of trails that weave through the natural fabric of forests, ponds, hilltops and wetlands. There are 22 hills in the Blue Hills chain with Great Blue Hill noted as the highest landmark at 635' above sea level.
